Dear Parents and Guardians:

As noted in a recent letter, the school district is short of bus drivers. Unfortunately, we will need to cancel some runs for the next week due to a driver shortage. Please refer to the list below to see how these cancellations will impact bus runs; we will continue to 'roll' the cancellation so no one run is impacted more than others. We understand that this is a potentially upsetting event, creating uncertainty and inconvenience, and as noted we are working to improve this situation with the addition of more drivers.
