What happens if you break the rules?

- st issue You will be issued a warning by the teacher or staff member. We expect you to comply with this request without becoming argumentative or defiant. Students not complying with this request may be sent to the administration.
- nd issue The PDD will be sent to the office and held by administration for the remainder of the school day.

- Cell phones or other personal digital devices ('PDDs') including smart watches or other smart communication technology, is not permitted during instructional times. Student PDDs may be used during non-instructional times
  - including before class, during breaks, lunchtime, and after Instructional time includes not just regular classroom
    - settings, but assemblies, guest speakers, field trips, and other events organized by teachers or administrators. Digital devices are not taken into test or examination settings
      - unless students have been given permission to do so for educational and/or medical reasons by the teacher Students must not use cell phones, video or audio recording administering the test or exam.
        - devices, or other digital devices in settings such as change rooms, washrooms, or private counselling rooms at any time that have the potential to violate a person's reasonable expectation of privacy.
          - rd issue You will be sent to the office, to hand in your device to the administration. A parent /guardian will be asked to pick up the device. A follow-up meeting may be held.
